

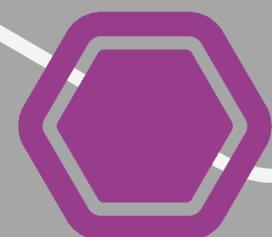

Since 2004, FTK has pioneered the Community Development Trust (CDT) model, leveraging trust-based savings groups to foster financial resilience, literacy, and climate-smart livelihoods. Partnering with the Anglican Church of Kenya, FTK operates across 21 counties, including Kiambu, Nakuru, Mombasa, Marsabit, and Kitui, reaching over 30,500 households with transformative impact.

To eradicate extreme poverty and restore the dignity of underserved populations resulting in strong communities and a sustainable environment.

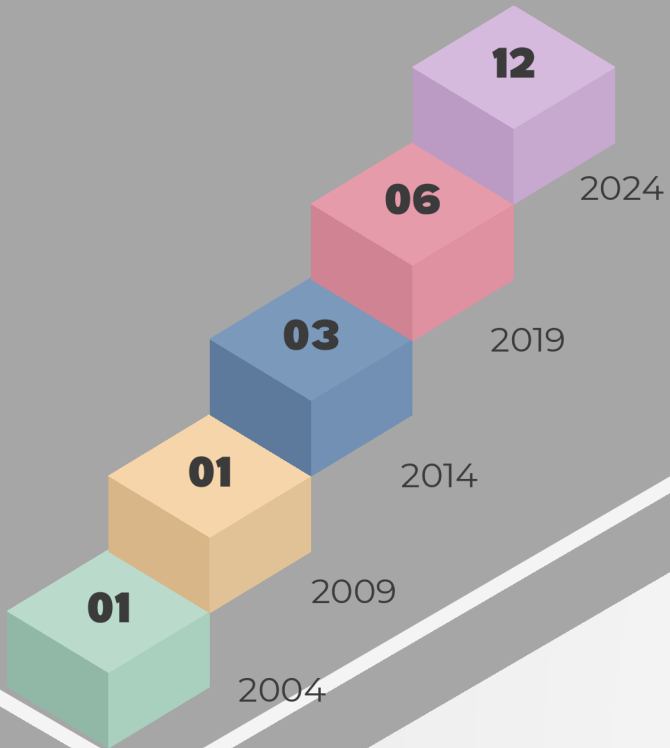

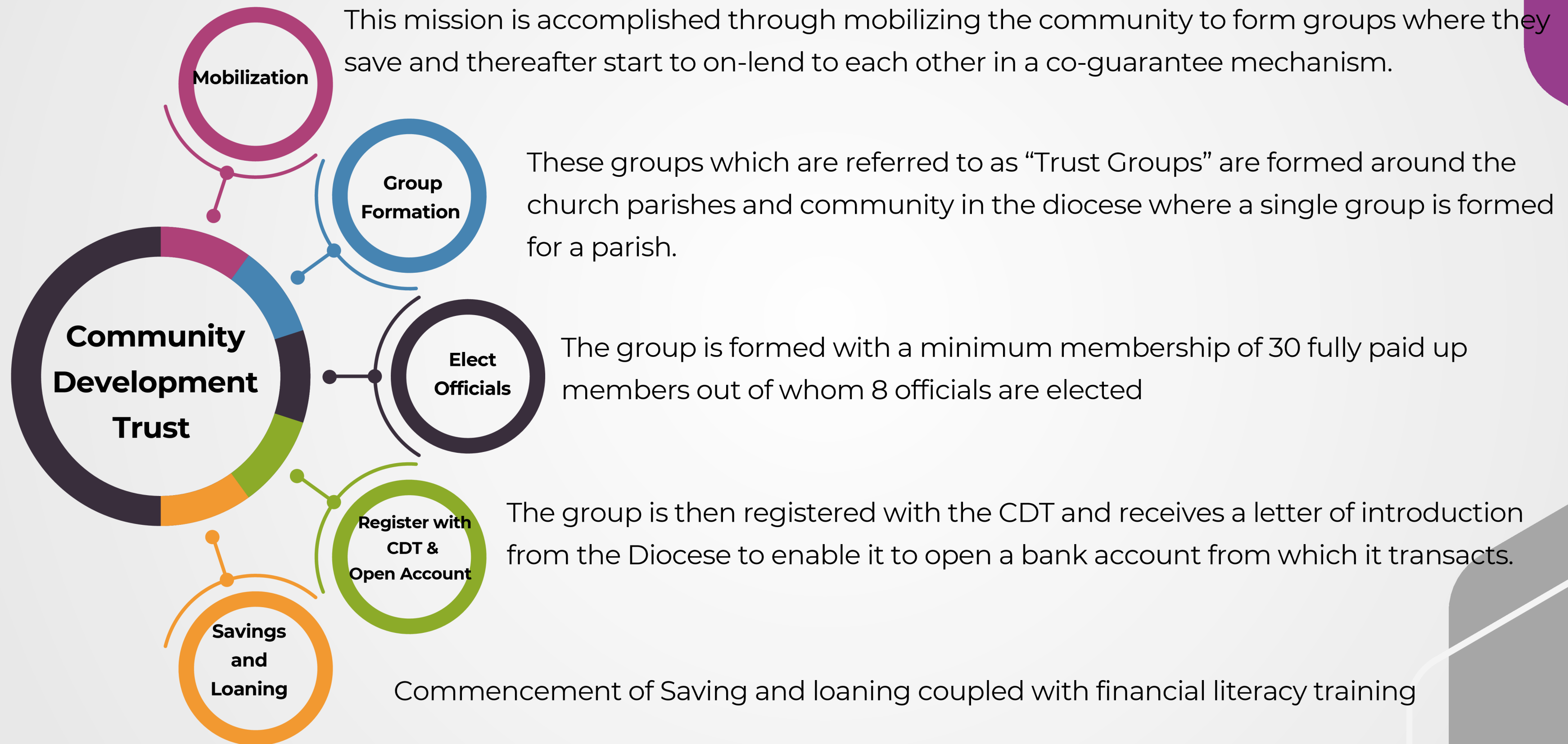

At the core of FTK's success is the Accumulated Savings and Credit Association (ASCA), an innovative approach enabling communities to pool savings, access low-interest loans, and invest in income-generating activities. These groups function as informal Savings and Credit Cooperatives (SACCOs), empowering individuals—particularly women and marginalized groups—excluded from formal financial systems. Through ASCA, members build sustainable ecosystems of mutual support, driving economic independence and community-led growth.
